Rt. Rev. Dr. Isaac Mar Philoxenos took his responsibility as the Diocesan Episcopa on April 1 2016. After his consecration as the Episcopa in 1993, he led Bombay- Delhi Diocese (1993 to 2001), Kottayam - Kochi Diocese (2001 – 2008) and Chennai- Bangalore Diocese (2009 - 2016). His visionary and social outlook and determination became instrumental in the starting of many projects like Navjeevan Centre in Mumbai, Gram Jyoti Schools in different parts of North India, Dharma Jyothi Vidhya Peeth, Faridabad and the constructions of the Mar Thoma Guidance Centre, Vyttila, Ernakulam, Retreat Home, Munnar and the New Building for Hospital and Guidance Home at Vellore. Along with the responsibility of the Diocese he serves as a member of the Central Committee of the World Council of Churches, the President of the Senate of Serampore College and Chairperson of Ecumenical Christian Centre, Bangalore.
